



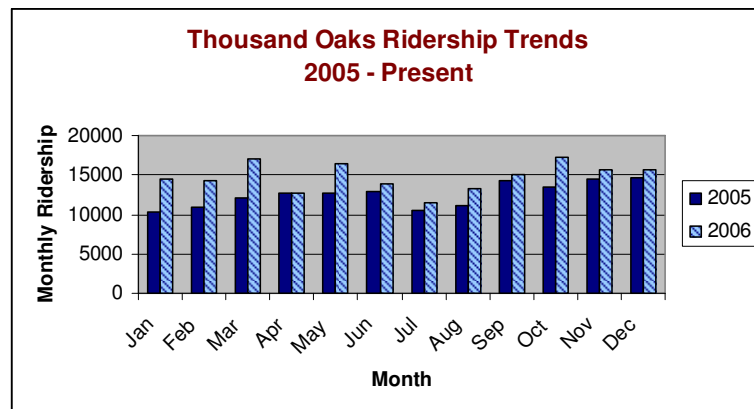

Thousand Oaks Transit Continues Upward Growth

Thousand Oaks, CA – In 2006, ridership aboard Thousand Oaks Transit (TOT) approached 177,000 passengers, a 13 percent increase over 2005. With ridership growth realized over the last 13 consecutive months, TOT is exhibiting industry-leading success.

Ridership in 2007 has picked up where 2006 left off. Ridership trends typically decline in winter months, but the new year started strong, with nearly 16,000 passengers riding in January 2007, an 8 percent increase over the same period last year.
