COUNTY TRANSIT LAUNCHES NEW WEBSITE

The San Benito County Local Transportation Authority (LTA) launched a new website this week, www.SanBenitoCountyExpress.org. The site provides San Benito County residents and visitors with detailed information on the many transit and other transportation services available through San Benito County.

Visitors to the site will find expanded transit route maps. A new transit planning tool for the Hollister Fixed Route and Intercounty Service will be launched by June of this year. Information on fares and passes, transfers, hours of operation and even tips on riding the bus are all available on the website.

The County Express system take passengers to approximately 25 locations throughout the County and Gilroy including such popular destinations as the Gilroy Caltrain Station, Gavilan College, Greyhound Station, San Juan Bautista, schools, shopping, service locations in Hollister and much, much more.

Details on specific routes, times, fares, etc. are also available for viewing at www.SanBenitoCountyExpress.org. In addition, the newly designed website also provides details on the ADA Dial-A-Ride (door-to-door) and Jovenes de Antaño services for those riders unable to access other transit options. The website provides information on eligibility, scheduling, pricing and more.

The newly designed website is part of a comprehensive update of the San Benito County Short Range Transit Plan. The purpose of the plan is to develop a program of transit improvements for the *County Express* transit service for the next five years.
