SYVT Accommodates Bicycle Riders

Solvang, CA – Santa Ynez Valley Transit (SYVT) has made additional efforts in its dedication to providing convenient transportation by installing easy-to-use bike racks on all of its buses. The racks, located at the front of the buses, allow bicycle riders to use SYVT's transportation services to facilitate their transit needs. Bicyclists now have the option of travelling throughout the regions of Buellton, Solvang, and Los Olivos without forgoing their two-wheeled companions. The installation of bike racks is among a number of upgrades SYVT has made as part of its dedication to providing affordable public transportation.

"Our goal is to make utilizing public transportation as easy and convenient as possible for everyone," commented Public Works Director Tully Clifford. "By installing bike racks on all our vehicles, we're looking forward to seeing more bike riders utilize SYVT as part of their trip."

To assist bicycle riders who would like to utilize public transportation in conjunction with riding their bikes, SYVT has produced an informative brochure.
