Burbank Bus Providing Connections to Greater Los Angeles Region

Burbank, CA. – Burbank Bus achieved a 14 percent increase in ridership during the month of April, translating into an additional 3,500 riders. Year to date, Burbank Bus has provided convenient and affordable transportation to nearly 113,000 riders throughout the City of Burbank. When compared with the same period a year ago, annual ridership has increased by nearly 11 percent.

Burbank Bus integrates the many transportation options within and surrounding the City of Burbank, allowing riders to connect to Metrolink, Metro Red and Orange Lines, and municipal bus services of neighboring communities. The system benefits locals and visitors alike, connecting transportation hubs such as Downtown Metrolink Station, NoHo Redline Station, and Bob Hope Airport to area employers and entertainment destinations.

“The City of Burbank is continually working to provide the community with the most convenient and affordable ways to travel,” commented City of Burbank Transportation Manager, Andrew Carrasco. “With the summer travel season approaching, Burbank Bus works to provide visitors with viable transportation options during their stay.”

Burbank Bus has developed another way for commuters to save energy while getting to work. The local bus system announced they will be adding bicycle racks to all fixed-route vehicles, adding further convenience for those using the combination of bicycles and transit.
